IMPORTANT

- Use this product with adult supervision only. Serious bodily injury could occur!
- Do not allow anyone to stand too close to the net or serious bodily injury could occur the net expands when a bat, ball, or object hits it.
- Do not leave this cage assembled during wind, rain, hail, or snow storms. The cage is not designed to withstand extreme weather conditions and damage to the fiberglass frames caused by extreme weather may not be covered in the manufacturer's warranty.





Rope Stakes & (White) Support Ropes


Note: Do not damage the upright tubing on the Ground Stake. This may prevent the frame tubing from inserting properly. Make Sure Stakes Are Perfectly Straight Up And Down.


STEP 2: End Pole Assemblies (Quantity 2), Middle Pole Assembly (Quantity1) (Refer to Part #'s Below.)

Slide each section together and tape together. Repeat for the second End Pole Assembly and Middle Pole Assembly.





(Tape each section together with Black Tape.)


Note: Position the Rope Rings in the same direction and when forming the arch be sure to face the Rope Rings to the inside of the cage area. This allows the netting to slide easier over the arched frame.



STEP 6: Hammer Rope Stakes (Part# I) into ground and tie Support Ropes between the Ground Stake and the Rope Rings on the frame arch. Make sure rope is tight.





WARNING


Make sure Heater Sports Pitching Machine is turned off and unplugged when attaching Batting Cage Net Harness Tube to Heater Sports Pitching Machine.

WARNING!


- Never allow a batter in the Batting Cage until the Heater Sports Pitching Machine has been sighted in and pitching at the desired target and at the right speed.
- Make sure Heater Sports Pitching Machine is turned off and unplugged when attaching the Batting Cage Net Harness Tube to the Trend Sports Pitching Machine.
- Make sure and disassemble the Xtender Batting Cage in stormy weather. The cage could break or blow over and cause property damage.
- Make sure area around batting cage is clear of people except for batter and machine operator. Bodily injury could occur if proper safety precautions aren't followed.
