

## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**


#### **BATTING TEE**

**STEP 1** - Make sure **PART A's** bottom is touching ground. In the center hole of **PART A (Base)**, Insert **PART C** into the three small holes surrounding the center hole on top of base as shown in *Figure 1*.



**STEP 2** - Turn **PART A** upside down and insert **PART B** into the center recess and align the lock holes with the three prongs of **PART C** as shown in *Figure 2*.

**NOTE:** Align **PART C** prongs with the large opening of the lock holes in **PART B** as illustrated in *Figure 3*.





Once the parts are aligned, twist **PART B** counter clockwise until tight.

## **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

BATTING TEE (Cont.)

**STEP 3 -** Screw the **STEM (Parts E-G)** onto **PART B** by twisting clockwise until tight, as shown in FIGURE 4.

> NOTE: The push pin should align with the back of the **BASE** when fully tightened and allow you to adjust the height of the tee by selecting the

various hole positions on the **STEM.** 

STEP 4 - Push PART H (Tee Top) onto PART G (Top Stem) until it stops as shown in FIGURE 5.

NOTE: PART H (Tee Top) is reversible and can fit either way.

**STEP 5** - You can now fill the BASE with sand or water to keep the batting tee from tipping over.

> After filling the BASE, push STOPPER (Part D) into the fill hole until it snaps tight.

The HittingStation #1 Tee is now fully assembled.

#### **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

BALL NET (Cont.)

**STEP 1** - Remove net from box and connect pole sections. Once assembled, take each end of pole assembly and place the bullet cap rods into the ground 8-9" to form an arch as shown in image.

**NOTE:** If the ground is hard, hammer a 9 inch screw driver to create a hole, then remove, and insert the pole section into the hole. **DO NOT** hammer the pole in to the ground. You will cut the bungee and void your warranty.

WARNING: USE EXTREME CAUTION WHEN ASSEMBLING POLES AND INSERTING INTO GROUND. FAILURE TO SECURE POLES COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS BODILY INJURY.

**STEP 2 -** Slide the net over the assembled poles as shown below.











**NOTE:** If the bottom of the **NET** is not touching the ground, pull one side of the **POLE ASSEMBLY** out of the ground and move closer to the other side until the **NET** has 3-4" of slack on the ground. You may also need to insert the pole section deeper into the ground in order to decrease the height.

The HittingStation #1 Net is now fully assembled.

For disassembly, repeat steps backwards.

## \*\*\*IMPORTANT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS\*\*\*



- 1) Tee the ball up within 6-8 feet from the net but not so close that you could hit the net with your bat. **DO NOT** use this product if you are not sure of your ability to hit or throw a ball into the net.
- 2) **NEVER** allow anyone (people or pets) to stand behind the net or in any possible path of a ball should you miss the net or should the ball go through the net.
- 3) **DO NOT** set up net where property damage could occur if the ball should miss or go through net.
- 4) Use common sense and all the same precautions as you would when playing baseball or softball.
- 5) Inspect the net before and during each use. If any rips or holes are found **DO NOT USE!** 
  - NOTE: Nylon cable ties are available from most hardware stores and can be used to repair small holes in the net. Be aware of any new holes that may open and if adequate repairs cannot be made, **DO NOT USE!**
